Our favourite 3 online image editors

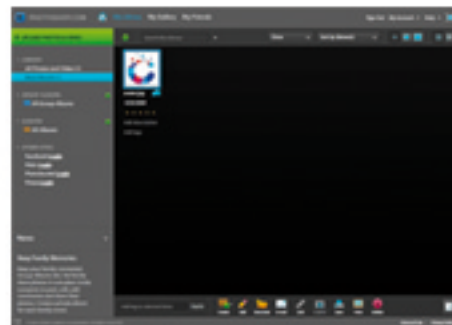
Aviary Phoenix - <http://aviary.com/>
